Not the difference as presented by man, but the difference as taught from the **Word of God.** There is a difference! A natural and logical question then would be, "What is the difference between Heaven and Hell?" **As we seek to answer this question, we need an absolute, authoritative source to draw upon.**

Il Timothy 3:16 All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

The Bible, then, is the source to which we look as the authority for determining the difference between Heaven and Hell. In doing so we find that:

Heaven is where God dwells, it's His home.

Isaiah 66:1 Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? and where is the place of my rest?

Matthew 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:
