DAVID'S REVIVAL

We can agree that America needs revival. Many preachers have preached on this fact-Pastor Joe Mann, Missionary Joel Sloan, and Evangelist Dennis Corle. Along with Jack Hyles (who is with the Lord), who held God save America conferences. We can all agree America needs revival. So, let's look at David's Revival.

Psalms 51:1-15 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. 2 Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. 3 For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. 4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest. 5 Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me. 6 Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom. 7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. 8 Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which thou hast broken may rejoice. 9 Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. 10 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. **11** Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me. **12** Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit. 13 Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee. 14 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation: and my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness. 15 O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall shew forth thy praise.

DAVID BECAME SORRY FOR HIS SINS Verses 1-6 **His Conviction:**

(V. 1-2) David was saying I am guilty Lord. I know I did it and that it's against you. I

did wrong Lord. I know you did not want me to do that.

His Confession: Psalms 51:3-4 For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. 4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest. An alcoholic must realize that they are an alcoholic. Sinners must realize that they are a sinners before they can get saved. Someone taking drugs must realize they are a drug addict before they can be cured. Sinners must realize and confess their sins before they can be forgiven. David's Contrition: 4 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest. David's attitude toward his sin- it was against God. "In thy sight" -God knows our sin. He sees it but we must recognize it. David's Cleansing: 7 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. David realized his sin and asked God to cleanse him. His sin was washed away- abolished forever! **HE BECAME SICK OF HIMSELF.** (vv. 10-12) *Psalms 51:10* Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. This is a good song to sing. Are you sick of your dirty rotten sins? I was.

David was sick of his wrong spirit. Are you? Are you sick of not having the right spirit; No peace with God? Look up to a Holy God and ask Him to forgive you of your sins. Ask God to create in you a new Spirit. Continued on Page 3
