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Purpose in Your Heart

Let's define purpose first.

1. (n.) A strong desire for achievement or success: Desire, aim, goal, objective 2. (n.) The ability to make up one's mind and carry out one's intentions: 3. (n.) The inherent idea imparted or expressed: 4. (n.) What one intends to do or achieve: 5. (v.) To endeavor to obtain or reach:

So with that being said let's strive to please the Lord. Seek after the things of the Lord, and set our sights on the Lord with all our heart. I would like to say -first, if you are not saved YOU NEED TO PURPOSE IN YOUR HEART TO GET SAVED. You can go to my web page, talk to a preacher, or a youth pastor, but purpose in your heart to talk to someone as quick as possible! This message today is to that person who knows for sure that they are saved. I would like to start today by having you open your Bible to Daniel chapter 1 and read verses one through eight. Daniel 1:8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank; therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself. You and I should purpose in our heart to study our Bible, 2 Timothy 2:16 But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. Many people do not like to study. I know a case where the Lord was dealing with a grown man about reading his Bible and studying it. The problem was he could not read. Many years later, he told me that his son taught him to read. He said, "I thought I was too dumb to read, but now I know I was just to lazy to take the time to learn."

No matter how hard you think it is- We just have to make it our goal to read it. We will not read the Bible if we do not purpose in our heart to do so. Try to read your Bible at the same time each day. I believe morning is best if you can. We are a busy generation, and we get so busy during the day that we just don't have the time and energy at night. As you read your Bible, find a verse and then Meditate on it. Meditate defined: Turn over in your mind, think over, dwell on, think about, empty the mind of thoughts, or concentrate the mind on one thing in order to aid mental or spiritual development, contemplation, or relaxation. I think we can get the picture; just find a verse, study it and then meditate on it. *Psalms 1:2* But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. My life chapter is Psalms 1. This chapter teaches us how to be extremely blessed by a Holy God. You see we can be saved but not blessed. You could say I only get a small blessing which is great, but extremely blessed is better. A good example of what we should do is what a cow does. Cows have 4 stomachs, they eat their food then bring it back up. Do like the cow does; chew the cud! Bring up the scripture again later and think about; meditate on it. This brings us to the next thing we should do.

The First thing we need to do is purpose in are heart to get saved, after we get saved we should study our Bible. In order to study it we should purpose in our heart to read it. Then we should find a verse and meditate on it. This brings us to another thing we should do when we are listening to the preaching of God's Word- <u>we should mark it</u>. **Why?**
