

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The Wizard Of Oz

In the last twenty years, there have been a lot of changes. For instance, in our Baptist churches you didn't have to worry that your Bible might not say the same thing as the preachers'. The King James Bible 1611 was the rule, NOT the exception.

Some examples

Fifty years ago, you did not have to tell children what they could wear to school because everyone had to dress decent. Twenty years ago, People were not ashamed to say that they got **SAVED!** Not that they had a conversion or a religious experience, but they had a true, soul shaking, tear shedding, life changing, Blood bought salvation!!! They had a law in New York state against queers. When I was a kid, gays were called queers and it was not a hate crime to call them queers. When I was in high school a teacher could read his or her Bible. When I was in kindergarten, they taught from the Bible. Everything has gone downhill in seventy years. Forty years ago, it was wrong for a boss to swear at a meeting; in 1957, it was wrong to shake your body the way MTV does on television.

No heart to tell people about Jesus. No heart to tell their friends how to go to heaven. Psalms 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. Most people say I cannot memorize Scripture. What they are saying is I do not have the heart for doing that. Hebrews 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is: but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching. Some people say I have a hard time getting up to go to church. What they are saying is I do not have the heart to do that. Not only did the Tin Man **not have a HEART, he was also RUSTY.** Remember, he was so **RUSTY**, he was frozen up. He needed some oil. **Christians** get rusty—they don't go soul-winning, read their Bibles, pray, tithe, go to church and they don't memorize **Scripture.** Think about it, the minute you and I go on vacation or get out of school—we immediately stop doing the things we should do. When you do not read your Bible nor pray the way you should, you get rusty! Example: When we are in a routinegoing to school every day or **reading every day**, it is easier on us than when we have to start up again. Reading your Bible is the same way. The Tin Man always carried an AXE. Today many teens & adults carry an **AXE** to grind against **something** or somebody. So many teens have hard feeling towards one another; they do not like this person or think that **person is a** jerk. Isn't that like many teens and adults today? Hold up that little pointed head of yours, Sissy! No COURAGE, no guts, no backbone— you probably have lace on your drawers and paint on your toenails! A lion is to be fearless! So are we... But, you're not, because your are scared that you will lose your friends (peer pressure). You are not a lion, but just a little pussy cat disguised as a lion. Proverbs 28:1 The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold as a lion. Acts 13:46 Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing ye put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles. It was necessary that the Word of God should first have

been spoken to you: Necessary=Required by obligation, compulsion. If people are going to get saved and not die and go to hell, we must have boldness.

So far, we have met two of Dorothy's helpers. One with no **HEART**, **RUSTY**, and carrying an **AXE** to grind, and the other **without any COURAGE**. And now, I would like to introduce to you the last helper, the Scarecrow. The Scarecrow had a problem—he **Had NO BRAINS**.

Example: You think with **your flesh:** You do not care what the Word of God says; you just want to do your thing, "I am going to have that girlfriend or boyfriend. I do not care if he or she is saved or lost. I do not care if they follow Jesus or not." 2 Corinthians 6:14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness? You do not care what God says; you do not care what your mom or Dad says. You are following a Tin Man with **NO HEART, RUSTY,** with an **AXE** to grind. You are listening to a Cowardly Lion and a Scarecrow with NO **BRAINS.** You are unwilling to wait and see who God has chosen for you to marry. You are afraid to catch on fire for Christ, instead you are falling for that boy or girl. You are saying, "If I get on fire for Jesus what will happen? If I wait for Jesus to lead me what will happen."
