

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# **Read and Study the Bible**

#### You Can Trust It.

The Bible has sixty-six books: thirty-nine books in the Old Testament and twenty-seven books in the New Testament. The Old Testament covers the period of time from the creation of heaven and earth *Genesis 1:1* until about four hundred years before Christ, (B.C.). The New Testament begins with the birth of Jesus Christ and projects into the future - the new heaven and the new earth *Revelation 21, 22.* The Bible is God's Book. God is the author although God used men to write down the words. We read in *2 Peter 1:21* For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. Also, we read in *2 Timothy 3:16-17* All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. God has both preserved His Word and kept it pure so that you can be assured that it is trustworthy without reservation. *Psalm 12:6-7* The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.

If you have just been saved, and you were not raised in a good Bible-believing church where you received some basic knowledge of the Bible, then the following brief study will help you to get started in God's wonderful Book and to understand what you are reading. Let's begin by reviewing the following basic commandments from the Word of God:

#### Desire the Word.

1 Peter 2:1-3 Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious. Certainly, if you have been saved by God's grace Ephesians 2:8-9, then you have "tasted that the Lord is gracious." There is no doubt that this verse is referring to a "newborn babe" in Christ Jesus who has been "born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever." 1 Peter 1:23 The commandment, then, is for YOU "to desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye [YOU] may grow thereby." A natural baby must have milk or he will get sick and die. A spiritual baby must also feed on the "milk of the word" or he will get sick and die spiritually. The Lord Jesus said John 6:63, "It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life." Romans 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you. The Lord said in John 10:10, "The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly."

If you have believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, then you have everlasting life (this means that you will live eternally with the Lord in a new and glorified body after He comes); but the Lord wants your present life on this earth to be abundant.

**Ephesians 2:10** For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. God has something for you to do in THIS LIFE, and a successful man will find out what God's will is for him and then do it.

#### Study the Word.

2 Timothy 2:15 Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. The Bible says in Ecclesiastes12:12 "And further, by these, my son, be admonished: of making many books there is no end; and much study is a weariness of the flesh." But "wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it." Proverbs 8:11

Men spend long hours studying for various reasons: to learn a trade, to become a professional doctor, lawyer, scientist, or engineer— and there is nothing wrong with that; however, God's wisdom is far above the wisdom of this world, and should never be neglected and pushed aside to be replaced with the wisdom of this world. 1 Corinthians 3:19 For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness. Proverbs 3:13 Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding. This wisdom is from the Lord: Proverbs 2:6-7 For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding. He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous: he is a buckler to them that walk uprightly. This wisdom is to be found nowhere else but in the Bible. The Bible is a gold mine of wisdom and understanding, and the child of God is instructed to get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth. Forsake her not, and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep thee. Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get under standing. Proverbs 4:5 -7

# **Continue in the Word.**

The Lord Jesus Christ told the Jews which had believed on Him, "If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." John 8:31,32 If is a big word which depends on your obedience and faithfulness to do what God has commanded you to do. The Lord Jesus clearly stated how your life for Him is measured when He said, "If ye love me, keep my commandments." The apostle Paul, writing in 1 Timothy 4:15, instructed Timothy concerning the scriptures, "Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all." There is no doubt in my mind of the truth of these statements, for I have profited greatly in spirit from the precious Word of God. Finally, listen to what the Lord told Joshua concerning His Word in Joshua 1:8, "This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success."
